

Red Rocks Park and Amphitheatre

Not far from downtown Denver is Red Rocks Park, a landscape of fantastic, eroded outcrops and grassy hills. The colorful rocks are truly ancient, approximately 290 million years old, and were formed from the erosion of the Ancestral Rocky Mountains. The red sandstone in the park is part of the massive Fountain Formation, which can be seen in other similar areas of Colorado and Wyoming. This nature park really rocks, and quite literally. Situated between soaring formations within the park is the renowned Red Rocks Amphitheatre, an outdoor music venue that opened in 1941 after the City of Denver acquired the park.

Red Rocks is best known today for its fabulous rock concerts. So memorable, in fact, are Red Rocks concerts that many artists have released audio and video recordings of their performances there. It has become an iconic American concert venue, hosting such world-famous musicians as The Beatles, Louis Armstrong, Stevie Nicks, B.B. King, Willie Nelson, U2, and many more. Now Red Rocks Park is getting ready to open another chapter in its music history as the summer concert season kicks off in April of this year.

Red Rocks' influence on pop culture goes well beyond music, too. The venue has been featured on episodes of The Simpsons, Dr. Quinn, Medicine Woman, The Amazing Race, and South Park. And with only a few exceptions for bad weather, Red Rocks has hosted a sunrise service every Easter since 1947.
