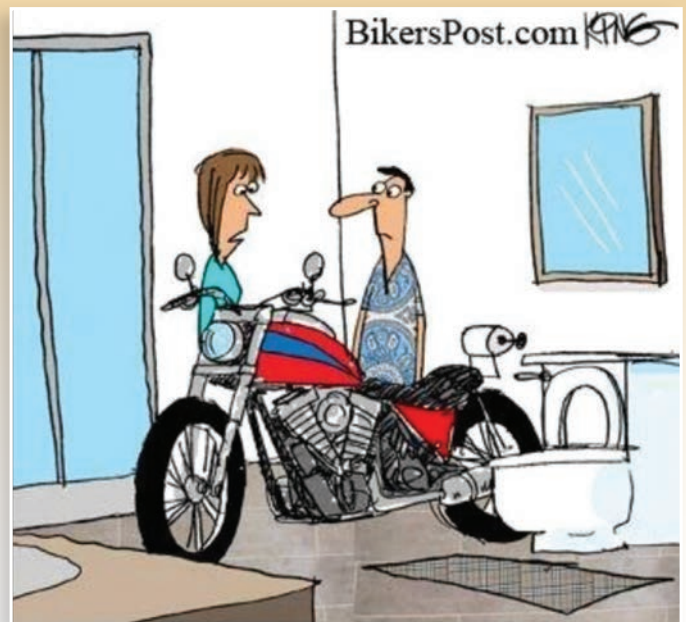
Here's 7 Tips that will save you time and stress on your next road trip, compliments of the American Motorcycle Association:

INSIDER SECRETS FOR YOUR NEXT ROAD TRIP

- 1) Eat at Weird Times:** Avoid the rush hour crowds at restaurants by planning to make your meal stops before/after 8 am, 12 noon and 6 pm.
- 2) Carry a spare Bike key.** Just attach the key to your bike using a zip tie or duct tape A little precaution can go a long way!
- 3) Use Trash Compactor Bags to Keep Your Saddlebags Dry.** Compactor bags are more durable and thicker than regular garbage bags, to give you that added protection on those long rainy rides.
- 4) Drive a Little /Save a Lot:** You can set yourself up for a quick get away, and avoid time lost in Urban traffic by going ahead and riding to the far side of the next city before calling it a day. Then, the next morning you are all set for a quicker and easier exit as you head to your next location.
- 5) Backpack Hydration:** Take a tip from non-motorist "bikers" and carry a backpack water system. It will save time stopping for water, and keep you hydrated while you ride!
- 6) Use Envelopes for Organization:** Rather than wasting time sifting through papers along your road trip, go ahead and sort each days information, tickets, reservation numbers, etc. and place them in envelopes marked for each day of your trip. That way, you can easily keep up with the details and spend more time enjoying taking in the sights.
- 7) Call ahead when booking your hotel rooms:** Believe it or not, call ahead room rates or online rates are often cheaper than walk-in rates. So go ahead and plan where you want to stay the night and book in advance. Who likes spending more money than you need to for the same rooms?

- 1) Harleys are safer than Hondas (from thieves...) We aren't weighing in on which Bike is best for riding, but, Insurance statistics show that in inner cities 1 in 5 bikes are stolen, and Honda is the most popular hot bike of choice for robbers. Interestingly, thieves are less likely to lift a Harley than a Honda!
- 2) First Bike: The very first practical motorcycle was built in 1885 by German inventor Gottlieb Daimler.
- 3) Ingenuity: The first Harley motorcycle was built in 1903 and used a tomato soup can as the carburetor!
- 4) Evel Knievel still holds the world record for breaking the most bones and surviving. Evel, a/k/a Robert Craig Knievel, spent a total of 3 years in the hospital during his illustrious career.
- 5) A Motorcycle's Front tires disperse water 3 times faster than its rear tires.

Three motorcycle museums...

If you want to see incredible collections of classic motorcycles, memorabilia and the like, then these three Biker Museums are just the ticket:

1) Wheels Through Time Motorcycle

Museum: Maggie Valley, NC. If you have never been to this quaint mountain area of the NC Mountains, the road trip and scenic vibe is worth the trip... but here's an added bonus for the history buffs in the group. This museum is set to re-open in April, 2019 and offers the world's premiere collection of rare American Motorcycles and memorabilia. Located just 5 miles off the beautiful Blue Ridge Parkway, and housing over 300 rare bikes, it's no wonder Trip Advisor gives this little gem a 5.0 with 1,000 Reviews!

2) National Motorcycle Museum:

Sitting quietly in the little town of Anamomsa, Iowa, this museum was founded in 1989 by motorcycle builders, racers and riders. It strives to maintain the experience of bikes, past and present. Here you'll be able to check out motorcycle memorabilia, documents and vintage bikes dating back to 1903!

3) Sturgis Motorcycle Museum and

Hall of Fame: Of Course the town of Sturgis, South Dakota would offer a historic look-back opportunity, given the town's claim to fame of hosting one of the country's major Bike Rallies. As you'd expect from the folks in Sturgis, this South Dakota museum boasts vintage and rare bikes, memorabilia, and all kinds of exhibits telling the story of the Sturgis Bike Rally through the years.
