

KEY WEST

While most vacationers hit up the pristine beaches or Disney World, as a motorcycle enthusiast you should seriously consider the run on the Overseas Highway from Miami to Key West. At 113 miles long, including the famous 7-mile bridge, the Overseas Highway is a must ride if you are going to spend time on two wheels in the Sunshine State. As you hang a right at Key Largo and head out onto Highway 1 you experience a one-of-a-kind motorcycle ride with the ocean hugging you on all sides. At the end of the ride is the infinitely guirky and hospitable Key West, famed for its pastel colored, conch-style houses and bars that close at 4am. Enjoy your time at the local watering hole, or jump on a local boat tour, but make sure you get a photo in front of the Southernmost Point of the Continental US monument to maximize the social media jealousy of the friends who didn't join you on the trip.

1) Pacific Coast Highway, California

Endless exploration and spectacular views greet you along the Pacific Coast Highway no matter where you start or stop. From San Diego, California to Seattle, Oregon the PCH delivers mountain views on the Olympic Peninsula, awe inspiring Redwood tree forests, gorgeous rolling coastal hills and some specular cities to visit in between.

2) Rocky Mountain National Park, Colorado

Pound for pound this ride might be the most spectacular route in the lower 48. After weaving through elk herds grazing in the grasslands you wind your way up to 12,183 feet at its peak. The road gracefully saunters back and forth across the top of the ridge with mountain ranges on both sides. There are a few spots to park and hike, and in the late spring and summer the blooming flowers make for a very Sound of Music atmosphere.

3) Covered Bridge Tour, Pennsylvania

Located in Bucks County, Pennsylvania the covered bridge tour features 12 covered bridges on a beautiful easy-going backroad adventure. Historically known as "kissing bridges", the covered bridge tour makes an perfect romantic 2-Up escape. Pack a lunch and enjoy a picturesque ride through 1800's Pennsylvania, your partner won't be disappointed.

4) Tunnel of Trees, Michigan

This ride is a top choice in the fall when the canopy of large trees transforms into a breathtaking view of fall colors. The Tunnel of Trees winds its way out of Harbor Springs, Michigan with some magnificent views of Lake Michigan sprinkled in for good measure. This relaxed section of Michigan is full of small towns with cool shops and unique Mom and Pop restaurants.

5) Pig Trail Scenic Byway, Arkansas

It has the least romantic name of our five choices, but the road and the views will not disappoint those looking to get out on the road with their significant other. Like the Tunnel of Trees the Pig Trail is great in the summer and spectacular in the fall with the colors on full display. As you make your way through the Ozark National Forest there are plenty of places to stop for food or go explore one of the many thriving small towns that are very welcoming to motorcyclists. Air BNB has some amazing options for romantic lodging off the beaten path.


