Brightening Your Day: The Best Place in the World to see Rainbows is in Hawaii



If you're a rainbow gazer and want to see as many of the beautiful phenomenon as possible, you should visit the state of Hawaii. A study published by the American Meteorological Society in 2021 says "the area's mountains produce sharp gradients in clouds and rainfall, which are key to abundant rainbow sightings". Air pollution, pollen, and a plentiful supply of cresting waves also helps to put Hawaii at the top of the list when it comes to rainbow quantity and quality.

A rainbow is caused by sunlight and atmospheric conditions and is really an optical illusion. Light enters a water droplet, slowing down and bending as it goes from air to denser water. So how does a rainbow actually happen? The formation of a rainbow is described step by step below:

- Sun rays strikes raindrop.
- Some of the sunlight is reflected.
- The rest of the light gets refracted.
- White light splits into different colors.
- Lights get reflected behind the raindrop.
- More refraction takes place.
- Color forms with more dispersion.
