

Can Your Insurance Premiums go up for using your MedPay or Underinsured Motorist coverage?

If you have Underinsured Motorist coverage and/or MedPay on your auto insurance policy, then you have chosen to have additional coverage if someone hurts you in a car accident.

- Premiums cannot be increased for using MedPay
- Premiums cannot be increased for using uninsured/underinsured motorist coverage

The answer is NO! According to statue CCR 702-5:5-2-12 titled "Concerning Automobile Insurance Consumer Protections," you cannot be penalized (like an increased premium) for using your own coverage if you are not at fault.
