Cranberry Salsa & Cream Cheese Spread

Ingredients

- 12 ounces fresh cranberries
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar (add more to taste)
- 1 jalapeno, seeded and chopped coarsely (leave the seeds in if you like it spicy)
- · 1/2 cup cilantro
- 4 green onions
- · 2 tablespoons lime juice
- pinch of salt
- · 28-ounce blocks of cream cheese

Instructions

Place all the ingredients in a food processor (EXCEPT CREAM CHEESE) and pulse until desired consistency. Chill in the fridge for a couple of hours, preferably overnight. Serve over cream cheese and with crackers.

Recipe Notes

This makes enough to cover two blocks of cream cheese. Depending on how tart your cranberries are, you may want to add more sugar.

Wheat Thins or Triscuits are great for serving with this because they are sturdy and won't break when dipping. Be sure you have a spreader to use with softer crackers.

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
